

CERTIFICATE IN THERAPEUTIC PLAY SKILLS

The programme aims to provide students with the opportunity to become creative and reflective practitioners of therapeutic play who contribute to supporting children's emotional development.



Therapeutic play skills add a therapeutic element to play work.

Completion of Certificate study enables students to use therapeutic play skills to provide emotional support for individual children with slight to moderate problems in schools and in primary health care settings.

Programme Structure

A part-time one year programme of study, structured across five weekends.

Programme Content:

- introduction to therapeutic work with Children
- using expressive arts as an intervention
- using theatre forms as an intervention
- use of symbolic play
